General Queries		
1	How will Indian Oil use GATE Marks	<p>Indian Oil will use GATE-2020 Marks for short listing the candidates who have applied to Indian Oil. Further selection process will comprise of Group Discussion (GD)/Group Task (GT) and Personal Interview (PI).</p> <p>Indian Oil will obtain GATE-2020 Marks directly from GATE authorities. Only those candidates, who have appeared and qualified in GATE-2020 in the relevant disciplines and have also applied in Indian Oil, would be considered for further selection process in Indian Oil.</p> <p>GATE-2020 Marks will have due weightage in the selection process along with marks scored in GD/GT and PI.</p>
2	Does one have to pay any application fees to Indian Oil?	No. Candidates do not have to pay any application fee to Indian Oil.
About eligibility		
1	GATE conducts its examination in so many disciplines. Will marks from all the disciplines be considered by Indian Oil?	No. Indian Oil will consider only the Marks obtained by candidate in GATE-2020 in the specified disciplines. For details please refer to our detailed advertisement available on Indian Oil website www.iocl.com .
2	I appeared in GATE last year. Will my GATE-2019 marks be valid for this year's recruitment exercise being done by IOCL?	No. score of GATE 2019 or earlier years will not be acceptable. Only valid marks from GATE 2020 shall be considered for recruitment in Indian Oil through this advertisement.
3	I am a student of M.Tech/ passed M.Tech. During my M.Tech admission, I appeared in GATE. Will my GATE marks based on which I got admission in M.Tech be considered by Indian Oil?	No. Indian Oil will only consider the GATE-2020 Marks.
4	I have completed my B.Tech in Mechanical Engineering and have completed my M.Tech in Power Engg. I have appeared in GATE 2020 in Electrical Engineering. Shall I be eligible for recruitment in Indian Oil?	No For recruitment in Indian Oil, you should have appeared in GATE-2020 examination in the discipline of your BE/B.Tech.

5	Is there any upper age limit for applying in Indian Oil	Yes. Please refer to our detailed advertisement for details about upper age limits and relaxation in upper age limits for different categories.
6	Is there any minimum % of marks requirement for applying in Indian Oil	Yes. For candidates belonging to General/OBC (NCL)/EWS categories candidates need to secure minimum 65% marks in their qualifying degree examination. For SC/ST/PwBD category candidates, it is relaxed to 55%.
7	I belong to General category and have obtained 64.99% marks in B.Tech. & applying for Engineers / Officers post. Will I be eligible for recruitment in Indian Oil considering that 64.99% may be rounded off to 65%.	No. Marks in qualifying degree examination will not be rounded off for deciding eligibility of any candidate.
8	Is there any physical fitness criteria for applying in Indian Oil	Yes. The candidates desirous of seeking employment with Indian Oil need to be medically fit as per pre-employment medical fitness standards of Indian Oil
9	I have got highest marks in a discipline in GATE-2020 and secured the first rank in my discipline. However, I did not apply to Indian Oil on-line within the stipulated window of application. Will IOCL consider my candidature based on my superior performance?	No. Indian Oil will not consider any candidature if he/she fails to apply in Indian Oil on-line within the stipulated window of registration. To be eligible for consideration a candidate has to necessarily apply during this stipulated window of application.
10	I could not apply to Indian Oil on-line. Can I apply to Indian Oil manually.	No. Only On-line applications made through our Online Application Portal are accepted by us .

About on-line application process

1	I do not have a printer attached to my PC which I am using for filling online application. Can I take print out of my application later after I submit my application	Yes. You can retrieve your application later and take printout. However, you have to store your unique IOCL ID registration number and GATE-2020 registration number safely for retrieving your application form later.
2	After submitting the application on-line, can it be viewed again?	Yes. Once submitted, it can be viewed. However, no changes in application can be carried out at this stage.
3	Can any information submitted at the time of on-line application be changed?	Once the application is finally submitted, no change in any field will be permitted Hence, the On-line application should be filled-in very with due care after going through all the instructions

		carefully. It should be reviewed carefully before final submission.
4	Where the university does not give percentage and only gives Letter Grades/CGPA/OGPA, how to fill-in the % of marks in the on-line application	The Letter Grades/CGPA/OGPA should be converted into percentage (%) as per conversion formula applied by the Institute/ University. In case of non-availability of such formula, Indian Oil will be at liberty to convert Grade/CGPA into % by applying its own procedure as it may deem fit.
5	I am not sure whether I fulfil the criteria for getting benefit under SC/ ST/ OBC(NCL) /EWS /PwBD category. What do I do?	The onus of claim to belong to any of these categories and providing a valid relevant certificate to this effect rests with the candidate. Hence, the candidate should satisfy himself/herself fully before claiming to belong to one of these categories. <i>In case it is found at any stage of recruitment process/ any time after recruitment, that the candidate has obtained reservation benefits by submitting false/ incorrect certificate/ information; the candidature of such candidates will be cancelled/ services terminated immediately.</i>
6	Who is entitled for relaxation/ concessions admissible to People with Disabilities (PwBD) candidates	Persons with disability of 40% and above and having valid disability certificate shall be eligible for benefits admissible to PwBD candidates.
7	My name on GATE Application is mentioned as Gupta S K while in my Class X pass certificate the same has been mentioned as Sunil Kumar Gupta. Please advise how should I fill in my name while applying for Indian Oil?	Once you input your GATE 2020 registration number, your name will be auto retrieved by On-line application system of Indian Oil. You need not input your name. But in case there is a mismatch in names (including the way it is written) in GATE -2020 application with that of a document like Class X/XII/ graduation mark-sheet, the onus will be on the candidate to establish that both the persons are same. If Indian Oil is not satisfied with the explanation/ proof provided, the candidature will be rejected.
8	Do I need to mail /post my completed application form with photograph affixed to Indian Oil?	No. Completed application need not be mailed or sent through post to Indian Oil. Application is to be brought at the time of GD/GT & PI, if shortlisted.
